# Jacob Albert and Elizabeth A Schmidt Voth

Grandpa Jacob Albert Voth was born 27 March 1892 in Hamilton County NE (near Henderson), the son of Jacob J and Anna J Toews Voth. His parents and their family moved from Hamilton County NE to near Kremlin OK in 1901, when he was 9 years old.



Elizabeth A Schmidt in the North Enid MB Church. They lived on the Voth homeplace (where Beverly Voth now lives) for most all of their married life, finally moving to 706 Mistletoe Drive, Enid OK for their later years. Grandma Elizabeth A Schmidt Voth was born 29 March 1896 near Henderson NE, the daughter of Abraham Heinrich and Katharina Johann Regier Schmidt.



Grandpa Voth was an innovative farmer and highly respected Red Poll dairyman for most all of his life; as he reached retirement age, he handed over his operations to his youngest son and namesake, Jacob A Voth, Jr. Jake loved to travel, especially on trains, and often took trips, sometimes with Grandma and Tena, sometimes solo, to CA, OR (lots of relatives in each), but also other locations such as AK. His storm cellar was a treasure trove of many shelves of railroading/train magazines and uncounted National Geographics, a favorite destination for his grandsons. His 1957 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary history of the N Enid MB Church, "Hitherto the Lord Has Helped Us" is well worth reading. Grandma Voth was a quiet, very good-hearted and devoted wife, mother, grandmother, homemaker, and excellent cook and baker - her swiebachs were, and still are, legendary!

In a meticulously typed letter to Kathy and me on 22 March 1973, Grandpa Voth asks, "Have you ever heard that when I was 13-14 years of age I was boarded out with Elizabeth's family at N Enid to attend German and Bible School. She was 9-10 yrs and we sometimes fought or argued in the home; didn't know at that time what Love was. 6-7 years later I did begin to like her for real and which led to our Marriage in 1916."

Grandpa Jacob A Voth started farming with horse-drawn implements and wagons, but lived to see two men walk on the moon - quite a remarkably rich and full life!

Jacob A Voth and his "courting buggy" (see my Mom's caption) midway between Enid and Kremlin OK are shown below.



Grandpa Voth was always an avid and very successful gardener, with his "lawn" full of iris, poppies, zinnias and all manner of blooming flowers and shrubs. A couple of B/W photos, from Grandpa's later years in Enid OK, taken by Francis Zaloudek, are included below.



Elizabeth and Jacob A Voth are shown in their backyard garden on the JAV homeplace in the panel below. Grandpa Voth was an accomplished iris propagator and actually named 2 cultivars of iris, one of them for Grandma Elizabeth Voth.



More photos of Jacob A Voth's "lawns" are below - the first three from the JAV homeplace and the last two from his Enid OK backyard. In the first, note our 1960 Chevrolet Bel-Air in the driveway and Grandpa Voth reading his newspaper, visible through this picture window. Top R shows Anna Voth Regier in the back yard.



Elizabeth died on 24 December 1972 at age 76, and Jacob at age 88 on 26 September 1980,

both in Enid OK. Jacob A and Elizabeth are buried in the North Enid MB Cemetery. Their youngest daughter, Tena M. (born 27 April 1926; died 5 January 1996 at age 69) is buried beside them in the same plot.

Voth died Friday in a local hospital after a period of declining health.

Born March 17, 1892, in Henderson, Neb., he was the son of Jacob J. and Anna Voth. In 1901, he came with his parents to Kremlin where he lived most of his

He has lived in Enid since about 1964. Voth married Elizabeth Schmidt on June 1, 1916 in Enid.

A member of the Enid Mennonite Brethren Church, Voth served for 30 years as a member of the Columbia district school board, 42 years as a member of the Kremlin precinct election, and 12 years with the Garfield County Red Cross chap-

Voth was a seven-year member of the Mennonite Central Committee in Oklahoma on the board of the Christian Rural Overseas Program, an affiliation of the Church World Service.

He was preceded in death by his wife and two sons, Menno and Jacob H.

Survivors include three daughters, Mrs. David (Rosa) Toews, Kremlin, Mrs. Jake (Anna) Regier, Enid, and Tena Voth, of the home; one son, Jacob Voth Jr., Kremlin; one sister, Mrs. Anna Thesman, Fairview; one daughter-in-law, Martha Voth, Enid; nine grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

The body will lie in state at the funeral home until 9:30 a.m. Monday and from 10 a.m. until service time at the church.

Memorials may be made to Oklahoma Medical Research Foundation and the Christian Rural Overseas Program. Ladusau-Evans Funeral Home will act as custodians of the funds.

### MRS. JACOB A. (ELIZABETH) VOTIL

Mrs. Jacob A. (Elizabeth) Voth, 76, 706 Mistletoe, died early Sunday morning in a Fairview hospital, following an extended illness.



She was born March 29, 1896 in Hamilton County, Neb. She moved with her parents to North Etid in 1900. She married Jacob A. Voth June 1, 1928. They made their home on a farm southwest of Kremlin until retiring in 1964. They have lived in Enid since that time. She was a lifetime member of the North End Mennonite Brethren Church.

She was preceded in death by her parents, an infant son, five brothers and two sisters. Survivors are her husband, Jacob, of the home; two sons. Menno W. of Enid and Jake, Jr. of Kremlin; three daughters, Tena Voth, of the botce; Mrs. David (Rota) Toews of Kremlin, and Mrs. Jacob (Anna) Regier of Enid; a brother, P. A. Schmidt, Dinuba, Calif.; nine grandchildren land grandchildren.

Funeral services for Mrs. Voth will be at 11 a.m. Thursday in the Enid Mennonite Brethren Church with Rev. Lymford J. Becker officiating. Burial will be in the North Mennonite Church cemetery, under the direction of Henninger-Allen Funeral







# The Homes and Farmsteads of Jacob A and Elizabeth Schmidt Voth

The farm home on Jacob and Elizabeth Voth's farmstead (top) and their farmstead in winter (bottom). In top photo, note the cellar entrance L of windmill and chickens, a bicycle, and the cistern just L of the kitchen entrance. In lower photo, note auto in garage and wash house/summer kitchen and outhouse between windmill and the house. This house and farmstead was also the home-place of Grandpa Jacob A Voth's parents, Jacob J and Anna J Toews Voth. This was the first home of Grandparents Voth we knew as kids.





Great-grandparents Jacob J and Anna J Voth (Grandpa Jacob A Voth's parents) and their parents, our GG-Grandparents Jacob and Anna Voth, all moved from Hamilton County NE to near Kremlin OK in 1901. The Jacob and Anna Voth family, including son Jacob J, had immigrated from Molotschna, S Russia to Beaver Precinct, Hamilton County NE in 1879 - see "Ancestors of Arrel Toews" for details and 1888 plat map (p 71) of Beaver Precinct, Hamilton County NE for locations of Voth, Schmidt, and Toews farms in NE. Both Jacob and Jacob J purchased farms near Kremlin in 1901 - GG-Grandfather Jacob the farm that became the farmstead of "Uncle Jake and Aunt Anna" Thesman (Jacob A Voth's sister), and G-Grandfather Jacob J what became the homeplace of our grandparents Jacob A and Elizabeth Voth. Jacob J purchased his farm from William Bentley for \$2000 on 4 April 1901. Myron Toews has documents and details of all family land purchases and sales. The 1906 Kremlin Township map (Ogle Garfield County OK Atlas) below shows the locations of the various Voth farms as well as

our Toews homeplace.



G-Grandparents Jacob J and Anna J Voth (Grandpa Jacob A Voth's parents) lived in the above house from 1901 until 1925 - presumably Jacob J either built or had the house built soon after purchasing the land in 1901. In 1925, they "retired" and moved to the farmstead we knew as Bob and Carol (currently Dean) Voth's 1 mile S and  $\frac{1}{2}$  E of the Jacob A Voth farmstead (see photo below). Jacob J built this house about 1925; presumably the photo below shows Jacob J and Anna J Voth in front of their new home.



Actually, the first home of Jacob A and Elizabeth Voth was on the "Butler Place" directly W of the Jacob J/Anna J Voth homeplace. Grandpa Jacob A Voth built this house for his new bride Elizabeth in about 1916, interestingly while Mr WP Butler still owned the farm! It was finally sold by the Butler family to Jake and Beverly Voth in the 1980s. When the Jacob J Voths moved into their new home in 1925, grandparents Jacob A and Elizabeth Voth moved  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile E into their parent's former home. This is where they lived when we were growing up.

Photos of the Butler house under construction in 1916, in the mid-1950s in the snow, and later (1970-80s) when Jake Voth Jr was farming this land and raising Hampshire sheep, are shown on the following page.

Menno, Rosa and Anna were all born in this Butler Place house. In addition to Jake and Elizabeth, it was also the first home of their youngest son Jacob A Voth Jr and wife Beverly; their son and his wife, Steve and Shirley Unruh Voth, first lived in a mobile home on this homesite (1979-80), between two elm trees planted by Beverly's father, Ferd Hamm. This house was moved to Lahoma in the early 1970s. Steve and Shirley just moved into their new home very near or upon the footprint of this "Butler House" (August 2022).


(R & bottom). Note colorful flower beds instead of lawn on the farm. Grandpa Voth's backyard in Enid was entirely flower beds as well.


# Menno W and Martha Warkentin Voth

Menno William Voth was born on 6 June 1917 near Kremlin OK, the oldest of 7 children of Jacob A and Elizabeth Schmidt Voth. On 29 June 1941, he married Martha J Warkentin in the N Enid MB Church. Martha "Mart" Warkentin was born 11 July 1921 in Joes, Yuma County, CO, the daughter of Abraham and Katharina L "Katie" Warkentin. In 1924, Mart's parents moved the family to Enid OK. The Warkentin's rented the same farm (see below) that Menno and Mart would later call home, moving there when Mart was 2 years old. She grew up on this farm.

For the first four years after marrying, Menno taught at Sunny Slope (1-room) School near Nine Mile Canyon NW of N Enid.

They then lived on a farm NE of N Enid OK (SW/4-21-23N-6W) - 1 mi E and  $\frac{1}{2}$  S of the US-81/Carrier Road intersection (Chisholm Trail monument). Menno operated a dairy for a number of years, and he also had a pear orchard. I remember helping Gene and sometimes his cousin Dennis Warkentin pick the pears and then wrap them in newspapers for ripening in Menno's round-top shed. Menno also had a hay-baling operation. Aunt Mart worked for many years at Bea's Bakery in Enid and also helped Menno with his dairy farming and pear orchard. She also worked for 10 years in the Garfield County Clerk's Office. Together, they also operated a Christian book and Bible store in Enid for several years as well. After Menno passed away, Mart spent her final years enjoying life at Golden Oaks Village in Enid. In her later years, she was an accomplished artist, working in both oils and watercolors.

Uncle Menno died in Enid OK on 7 December 1976 at age 59, and "Aunt Mart" died in Enid OK on 12 May 2013 at age 91. Both Menno and Mart are buried in the N Enid MB Cemetery.

Family Information file

David Abraham Toews, my father, was born on 20 October 1916 on our family farm ~1.5 mi W of Kremlin OK (NE/4-20-24N-6W), the youngest of six children. His wife (my mother), Rosa Marie Voth Toews, was born 15 September 1918 on the Butler Place (SW/4-19-24-6; N across from our Houghtaling Farm) near Kremlin OK. David and Rosa were married on 3 August 1943 in the North Enid Mennonite Brethren Church They lived most all of their married life on the George P Toews home-place  $1\frac{1}{4}$  mi W of Kremlin OK.

David farmed most of his life, including renting farms from Uncle Henry and Uncle Pete Toews. He raised wheat, silage, cattle, and registered Hampshire sheep, and also drove a bus for Kremlin School, while Mom was homemaker and legal secretary for Belcher, Belcher & Collins in Enid OK.

David passed from this earth at age of 87 on 12 December 2003, and Rosa on 25 February, 1998 at age 79, both in Enid OK. Rosa and David are buried in the North Enid MB cemetery.





# Anna Elizabeth Voth and Jacob William Regier

Anna Elizabeth Voth was born 4 January 1921 near Kremlin OK. On 3 May 1946, she married Jacob William Regier, born 6 December 1923, the son of Isaac I and Sarah Rempel Regier, in the N Enid MB Church.

Uncle Jake was a prosperous hard-working farmer all of his life and Aunt Anna a devoted mother, wife, and excellent cook - her swiebachs rivaled those of Grandma Voth's, always my favorite. The Jake Regier family first lived on a farm ("Toews Place"; SW/4-13-23N-6W) 4 mi E of the US-81/Carrier Road intersection (Chisholm Trail marker). This is the road that goes past the N Enid MB Church & Cemetery site. They later moved 1 mi W to another farm (SW/4-14-23N-6W), also on Carrier Road. I have many fond memories of visiting both homesteads, the insides of both houses and barns, and playing with Kathy and Jeanette, plus stacking hay bales in Uncle Jake's barn.

Myron and I have lots of fond memories of staying at Grandma and Grandpa Voth's houses on the farm, spending time with Tena, playing upstairs in the old house and in the basement of the new one.

<u>Tena</u> died in Fairview OK on 5 January 1996 at age 70; she is buried alongside her parents in the N Enid MB Cemetery.

## Jacob Abraham (Jr) & Beverly Hamm Voth

Jacob Abraham Voth ("Jr") was born on 23 January 1928 on the Jacob A Voth farm SE of Kremlin OK, the youngest of 7 children. On 14 October 1951, he married Beverly Jane Hamm, daughter of Ferdinand and Marguerite Just Hamm, in the Fairview OK MB Church.

Jake Jr worked beside Grandpa Voth in his farming and dairying operations and took over entirely when Grandpa retired in 1964/5. They originally lived on the Butler Place, across from the Houghtaling Farm, then moved to Grandpa Voth's 2<sup>nd</sup> house on the Voth homeplace in 1964 when Grandma, Grandpa & Tena moved to Enid. Like his father, Jake Jr was a hardworking well-respected farmer/dairyman known for his deep plowing furrows and laser-straight wheat sowing rows. He continued the tradition of



maintaining the excellent and highly respected Voth Red Poll herd, eventually passing this legacy on to his daughter Pam and son-in-law Dennis Schoenhals, as well as to their two sons, Ty and Trev. Along with our family, Jake, son Steve, & daughter Pam raised and exhibited registered Hampshire sheep. Beverly worked in Enid at Newman's on the Square, then later at the Garfield County Assessor's Office from 1972-1995, then finally at the Bank of Kremlin for 10 years (1996-2006). Jake worked at the County Assessor's Office for several years as well.

Jake and Beverly have a son, Steven Scott (DOB 13 April 1955; married to Shirley Diane Unruh) and a daughter Pamela Jane "Pam" (DOB 14 December 1958; married to Dennis Schoenhals). Steve and Shirley lived near Reedley CA until 2021 (new home on the Butler Place) and Pam and Dennis live on the Voth homeplace, just E of Beverly's home.








